1. WHAT ARE THE MEDICATION CHANGES? DID MEDICATIONS GET ADDED, DISCONTINUED, OR CHANGED?

Ask if there were any changes made to your medication during your hospital stay and why those changes were made. Note down what medications you should take when you go home.

3. WHERE DO I GO TO GET MY MEDICATIONS AFTER DISCHARGE?

Your health care team may have made changes to your medications during your hospital stay. To ensure that these changes are made to your home medications you will need to have your prescriptions filled at a community pharmacy. Make sure you let the health care team know the name and location of your preferred pharmacy. Also let them know if you would like to organize bubble packing and/or require delivery services.


